Drawing from examples in literature as well as Italian history, this paper examines three ways in which memory can be used: as a monument, to glorify our past and our identity; as reflex, as an involuntary and uncontrolled mental activity; and as disturbance, as the recollection of events and attitudes that undermine and question our assumptions about ourselves and our identity.
